NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

What is it about the character of Sherlock Holmes that still resonates with us over 135 years after he first appeared in print? Perhaps it is a fascination with his intellect and curiosity combined with a reassurance that even a genius such as Sherlock has his quirks. And being assured that - for the most part - those traits stay constant no matter the portrayal. We can rely on Sherlock to be, well, Sherlock, complete with a slightly oddball yet endearing relationship with his trusty sidekick Dr. Watson. We hope you enjoy *Miss Holmes* as it both reinterprets and reinforces the characters we know and love and that you will find the story new, exciting, and familiar all at the same time.

This clever reimagining of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle's iconic characters asks, what if these characters had been women? It pits its heroes not only against cunning criminal masterminds, but also against the rigid and restrictive rules of Victorian society. The game certainly is afoot when an anonymous letter sends a newlywed wife looking for help and her case is taken by two fiercely intelligent and independent women who refuse to be contained by the conventions of their time: Miss Sherlock Holmes and her stalwart companion Doctor Dorothy Watson.

Beyond the plot and familiar characterization, I was drawn to this story because of its willingness to explore the roles of women in oppressive societies and what happens when strong and cunning women are underestimated. I was even more excited when I realized that playwright, Christopher M. Walsh, wove solid historical information into his story and that our Westfield Theatre students would have the opportunity to use their research and creativity to immerse our audiences in the realities of the Victorian era. For example, Elizabeth Garrett Anderson was indeed the first woman to qualify in Britain as a physician and historians continue to argue that women were actually incarcerated in insane asylums such as the real Bethlem Royal Hospital more often than men. Women were considered "lunatics" and tortured for reasons so shocking as to ask for divorce from abusive husbands.

We hope you'll enjoy being challenged to solve the mystery alongside our intrepid version of Holmes and Watson as they work with and break through London's institutions and societal norms to crack the case and prove women can truly do anything.
